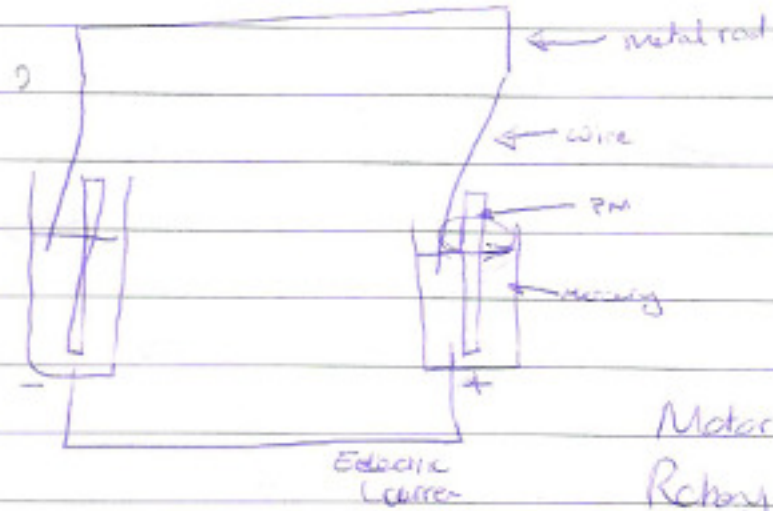
Charles the eldest in the family ^{was} was a

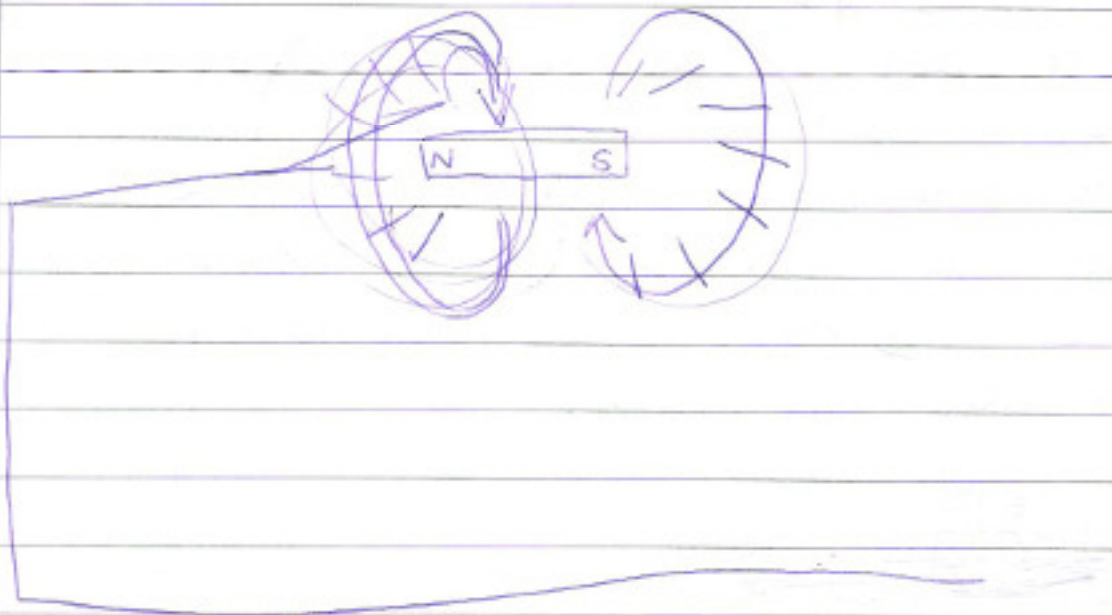

it was already midnight!

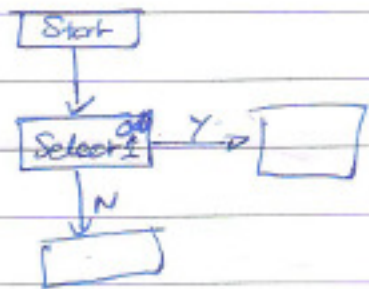

Hetty had an idea.

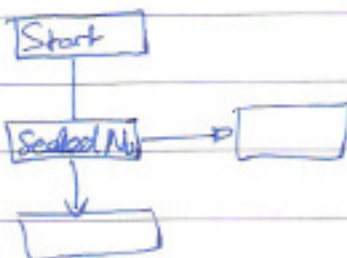
